I. Introduction

- 1. Article 5, paragraph 5, of the Rotterdam Convention states:
 - "The composition of the prior informed consent regions shall be defined in a decision to be adopted by consensus at the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties."
- 2. Discussion of the composition of the prior informed consent (PIC) regions occurred at the sixth, seventh, eight and ninth sessions of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee.

II. Background

- 3. In paragraph 5 of the resolution on interim arrangements adopted by the Conference of Plenipotentiaries on 11 September 1998¹, the Conference invited the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee to develop, based on the regions of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), the decision referred to in paragraph 5 of article 5 of the Rotterdam Convention, and to adopt this decision on an interim basis pending its formal adoption at the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties.
- 4. At its sixth session, the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee in Decision INC-6/1 agreed to base the interim PIC regions on the FAO regions, with the assignment of participating states which were not members of FAO to appropriate regions, respecting their natural geographical affinities and with the proviso that such adoption was on an interim basis only and that the final determination of PIC regions would be made by the Conference of the Parties. Decision INC-6/1, listing interim PIC regions, is contained in annex I to the present note.
- 5. At its seventh session and in subsequent written comments, the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee noted that the seven interim PIC regions had met the needs of the interim PIC procedure and that they should also meet the needs of the Convention PIC procedure. The maintenance of the existing PIC regions would both build on the progress achieved under the interim PIC procedure and facilitate the transition to the Convention PIC procedure. The seven regions also facilitate the identification of candidate chemicals by broadening the possibility of having at least one verified notification of final regulatory action from each of two PIC regions, in line with article 5, paragraph 5, of the Convention (UNEP/FAO/PIC/INC.9/18, para. 13).
- 6. It was agreed by the working group on discontinuation of the interim prior informed consent procedure established at the eighth session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee that the experience gained with the interim PIC regions should be given full consideration by the Conference of the Parties in deciding on the PIC regions. Some participants indicated concern that at the time of the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties, the distribution of the Parties across the interim PIC regions might not satisfy article 5, in particular the requirement for at least one notification from each of two PIC regions (UNEP/FAO/PIC/INC.9/18, annex 1, para. 10). A list of the Parties to the Convention may be found in document UNEP/FAO/RC/COP.1/INF1.
- 7. Following its consideration of this issue at its ninth session, the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee decided to forward two options on the composition of the PIC regions to the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties (annex III, UNEP/FAO/PIC/INC.9/21).

III. Issues for consideration by the Conference of the Parties

- 8. The Conference of the Parties is invited to consider the composition of the PIC regions and, as appropriate, adopt a decision on PIC regions, in accordance with article 5, paragraph 5, of the Convention. The formal decision on the composition of PIC regions is to be adopted by consensus.
- 9. The Conference of the Parties may wish to consider the following options proposed by the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee at its ninth session:
- (a) That the PIC regions to be adopted at the first Conference of the Parties be based on the geographical distribution of the Parties at that time;
- (b) That the PIC regions to be adopted at the first Conference of the Parties be based on the regions used during the interim PIC procedure, pending consideration of the geographical distribution of Parties at that time.
- 10. The Conference of the Parties may also wish to consider the text of possible draft decisions for each of these options set out in annex II to the present note.

Draft decision for consideration by the Conference of the Parties on the composition of PIC regions

Option (a)

The Conference of the Parties,

Noting that paragraph 5 of Article 5 of the Rotterdam Convention provides that the composition of the prior informed consent (PIC) regions shall be defined in a decision to be adopted by consensus at the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties,

Having considered decision INC-6/1 in which the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee adopted interim PIC regions for the purpose of the implementation of the interim arrangements for the application of the PIC procedure, pending the formal adoption, by consensus, of a listing of countries by PIC regions by the Conference of the Parties at its first meeting,

Noting the options for consideration proposed by the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee at its ninth session regarding the composition of PIC regions,

Considering that the composition of PIC regions should be based on the geographical distribution of Parties at the present time,

Decides to adopt the regions and listing of countries contained in the annex to the present decision, which is based on the geographical distribution of the Parties at the present time, as the PIC regions for the Convention.

Option (b)

The Conference of the Parties,

Noting that paragraph 5 of Article 5 of the Convention provides that the composition of the prior informed consent (PIC) regions shall be defined in a decision to be adopted by consensus at the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties,

Noting decision INC-6/1 in which the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee adopted interim PIC regions for the purpose of the implementation of the interim arrangements for the application of the PIC procedure, pending the formal adoption, by consensus, of a listing of countries by PIC regions by the Conference of the Parties at its first meeting,

Noting the options for consideration proposed by the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee at its ninth session regarding the composition of the PIC regions,

Taking into consideration the geographical distribution of Parties to the Convention at the present time,

Considering that the seven interim PIC regions set forth in INC-6/1 have met the needs of the interim PIC procedure,

Considering that an approach based on the regions used during the interim PIC procedure will both build on the progress achieved under the interim PIC procedure and facilitate the transition to the PIC procedure under the Convention,

Decides to adopt the regions and listing of countries contained in the annex to the present decision, which are based on the interim PIC regions, as the PIC regions for the Convention.
