Dear PIC Secretariat

This message is sent in response to your request for supporting information regarding Canada's notification of regulatory action for endrin.

The regulatory action notified was taken in 1990 as a final step to eliminate endrin use in Canada. The action was taken following indication from the registrant that they would no longer manufacture endrin, and the Canadian registration for the single remaining product ended.

Due in part to the age of this regulatory action, sufficient documentation could not be located and Canada will not be providing supporting documentation for review by the Chemical Review Committee.
